



## **Motor Cars and More**

The **161 Club's** Winter Automotive Heritage Tour  
in Naples Florida

**February 19 through 22, 2009**

Revel in sunny Naples, Florida while you enjoy tours of three automobile collections and scenic excursions exclusively for members of the *161 Club*.

### **Thursday February 19, 2009**

Arrive at the Hilton Naples in time for 3:00 p.m. check-in. The "Motor Cars and More" Tour will begin at 6:30 p.m. with a welcome party featuring cocktails and dinner at the Hilton Naples, our headquarters hotel.

### **Friday, February 20, 2009**

After breakfast at the hotel, the tour will get rolling when we travel by deluxe motor coach to Punta Gorda. If you miss breakfast, we'll have some substantial snacks for everyone on the bus. Upon arrival, we'll visit Rick Treworgy's all GM collection. While strolling through the new building housing this 200 car collection, you'll see many Corvettes and Camaros, some Pontiacs, Chevilles, and other GM cars. The "Miss Budweiser" unlimited hydroplane is on view along with its trailer and hauler. Of course, automotive memorabilia is everywhere in the building.

Then, we're off to a delicious lunch in the Conquistador Room, our private dining room at The Captain's Table on the tip of Fisherman's Village overlooking Charlotte Harbor. After lunch, we'll return to the hotel. You'll have time to refresh yourself and dress for dinner.

Later, our motor coach will take us to the Port-O-Call Marina to board the "Naples Princess", ([www.naplesprincesscruises.com](http://www.naplesprincesscruises.com)) an elegant 93 foot luxury yacht with first class amenities from port to starboard. As the sun sets, the ship will cruise the Naples Bay en route to the Gulf of Mexico. Along the way we will pass multi-million dollar homes

in Port Royal. Cocktails and dinner will be served in a private salon. Afterward, the motor coach will deliver us back to the Hilton Naples.

**Saturday, February 21, 2009**

The tour gets rolling again when our deluxe motor coach takes us to the Collier Museum, a collection of more than 75 classic sports cars purchased from Briggs Cunningham. Miles Collier added to his premier collection by individual acquisitions of exotic cars. The vehicles on display represent every decade of the twentieth century.

After posing for a group photo, we'll head to Frascati's, a local Italian restaurant for lunch.

After lunch we will board our deluxe motor coach and travel on the colorful Tamiami Trail to Everglades National Park. Our two-hour tram tour in Shark Valley will explore 15 miles of saw grass wilderness. A naturalist guide will provide insights into the eco system, and the open vehicles will allow us to view the wildlife in the saw grass prairies on either side. A panoramic view of the Everglades is available from the 45 foot high deck of the observation tower. A gradual ramp provides easy access to the deck and varying views of the Everglades. During the drive back to the hotel we will enjoy some snacks. After freshening up, we will have dinner at the Naples Beach Hotel.

**Sunday, February 22, 2009**

We'll begin the day by checking out of the hotel and storing our luggage in the hotel's secure storage area. Then we'll board our private Naples Trolley for a guided tour of Naples, including historic landmarks, beautiful beaches and waterways, and other local attractions while our guide relates historical facts and local stories. The Trolley Tour will end with a short drive to a car condo.

CARS, Collectors And Restorers' Square, houses about 60 vehicles along with a couple restoration shops. After viewing the cars, members of the Naples/Marco Island AACA Region will drive us in their vintage cars to the Hilton Hotel where we'll have lunch. Then, we'll say *ciao* – until the May 2009 tour in the historic Motor Cities area of Michigan.
